



## **“Friends of EcoPark” Scheme Turning waste into resources and leading to a greener Hong Kong**

[Hong Kong, June 17, 2013] The development of the EcoPark aims to provide long-term land at affordable rent for the development of the recycling and environmental industry with a view to encouraging investment in and development of more advanced and value-added environmental and recycling technologies.

Started in 2010, the Environmental Protection Department (EPD) and EcoPark Management Company (the Company) have jointly launched the “Friends of EcoPark” Scheme (the Scheme) to promote recycling and environmental awareness in private and public sectors, and to induce successful partnership with the EcoPark tenants for collaboration and support of their recycling business in the form of waste source supplies; co-ordination of waste collection; or regular use of recycled products produced by the EcoPark tenants.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> “Friends of EcoPark” Award Presentation Ceremony was held in great success in Hong Kong Productivity Council on Monday, June 17, 2013, a certificate was presented to each awarding company or organization with the aim of commending for its long-term commitment in environmental protection and generous support given to the EcoPark tenants. An overwhelming result was received this year, with a total of 92 companies and organizations were awarded, driving much support for the local recycling industry.

Operating since 2007, all fourteen lots of the EcoPark have been leased for the recycling of waste cooking oil, waste metals, waste wood, waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE), waste batteries, construction and demolition waste (C&D waste), waste glass, waste rubber tyres and food waste. Among which, two waste recycling centres have been set up and are managed by non-profit making organizations for waste plastic and WEEE recycling; two private recyclers will commissioning in the third



quarter this year, they are K. Wah Construction Products Limited which recycles C&D waste and waste glass to eco-blocks/pavers, and Chung Yue Steel Group Company Limited which recycles waste metals.

At the sharing session of the ceremony, representatives of the EcoPark tenants and awarding organizations demonstrated how more collaboration could be explored and a circular economy could be created. Champway Technology Limited, one of the EcoPark tenants, showcased its commitment to recycling waste cooking oil and organic oil and grease to renewable energy -- the biodiesel, reduces greenhouse gas and the impact on global warming, and protects the public health by avoiding the re-consumption of “gutter oil”.

K. Wah Construction Products Limited, another new tenant in the EcoPark Phase 2 which will start its commissioning in the third quarter this year, unveiled its production process of eco-blocks/pavers, and how eco-blocks/pavers could be made of C&D waste and waste glass, and what comparative advantages could be gained when producing and applying eco-blocks/pavers block to traditional blocks/pavers. Two awarding organizations, the Construction Industry Council - Zero Carbon Building and the Super Star Group, also shared how the Scheme has helped create win-win situation for partnering enterprises and recyclers.

Besides, all the remaining new EcoPark tenants will start their commissioning by next year, it is believed that the demand for recyclable waste materials will increase and the pressure of waste disposal at our landfills will alleviate. In the future, much more participation needs to be gained from the EPD and the Company in assisting the development of the environment industry and releasing sustainable development. We will draw up and promote good practices of waste reduction and recycling at commercial and industrial establishments, and facilitate waste supply to the EcoPark tenants through various campaigns.



And the Scheme itself will continue to encourage sustainable collaboration between private and public sectors and the EcoPark tenants, providing suitable recyclers with waste materials for turning into resource, adoption of green procurement policy to help create a market for environmentally friendly products -- building a circular economy and a long-term commitment to environmental protection and conservation.
